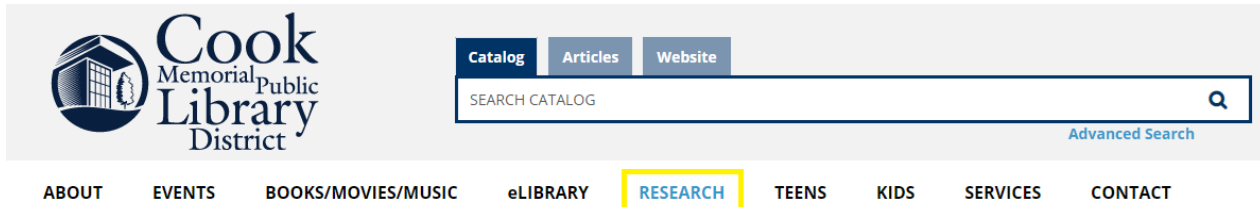
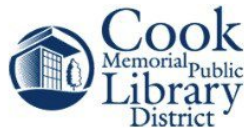


1. You can find PressReader under the “Research” tab on the library’s website. Navigate to [cooklib.org/research](http://cooklib.org/research) or click the link from our home page [cooklib.org](http://cooklib.org). You can do this on a desktop browser or a mobile browser.



2. Databases are listed alphabetically. Scroll down to “P” to find the PressReader link. You must create your PressReader account using this link to associate your account with the library.

3. Once you click the link, you will be brought to a page that prompts you to enter your library card number. Type your number in the box with no spaces and click submit.






5. Clicking this link will open a window for you to either sign in or create an account. Click the link that says “New User? Sign up now.”
