Report of the Director June 2023

David Archer, Library Director

Legislative Update

- The Illinois Secretary of State's Office / State Library **earmarked \$5 million for statewide access to online research databases** in the state's FY 24 budget. Resources are expected to be available to everyone in the state at no charge, including those residents who currently do not receive public library service. Specific resources to be included have yet to be determined, but the possibility exists that some databases could be cut from CMPLD's budget if the State Library begins offering free access. In a survey with libraries across the state, a number of subscription databases were identified as high priority, including Ancestry.com and World Book Online.
- Both the Illinois Senate and House passed the License to Read Act which authorizes the State Librarian to negotiate with publishers of e-books and e-audiobooks on behalf of libraries on reasonable terms that would enable libraries to acquire necessary licenses to provide library users with access to e-books and e-audiobooks.
- On June 12, Governor Pritzker signed **House Bill 2789**, which is the bill that amends the Illinois Library System Act by adding language that in order to be eligible for State grants, library materials should not be proscribed or removed because of partisan or doctrinal reasons. The law will take effect on January 1, 2024. The Illinois State Library will develop administrative rules soon that will guide libraries on how they can comply with the new law. Once these rules are developed, libraries will have an opportunity to provide feedback before the rules are finalized. A more detailed overview of this bill was provided in May's Report of the Director.

Aspen Drive Facilities Update

- Last fall, the new bollard lights and the original ground lights on the east side of the Aspen Drive Library stopped functioning and temporary solar lights were installed until a fix could be determined. After consulting with several electricians, it was determined that the electrical boxes feeding the ground lights were becoming saturated with water, causing the ground lights to malfunction. The new bollard lights also stopped working because they were part of the same wiring system as the ground lights. During the week of June 12, electricians began to replace wiring in underground conduit, install waterproof wire connectors and raise the electrical boxes above ground level at a cost of \$3,250, which was much lower than other estimates for more invasive solutions.
- Installation of new hinged, swinging doors for the Aspen Workshop is scheduled for June 20. The new doors replace the sliding doors.

- All patron computers are scheduled to be replaced with new models the week of June 19. All staff computers will be replaced later this summer. On an annual basis, funds are reserved for technology replacements, including PCs servers, switches, firewalls, etc.

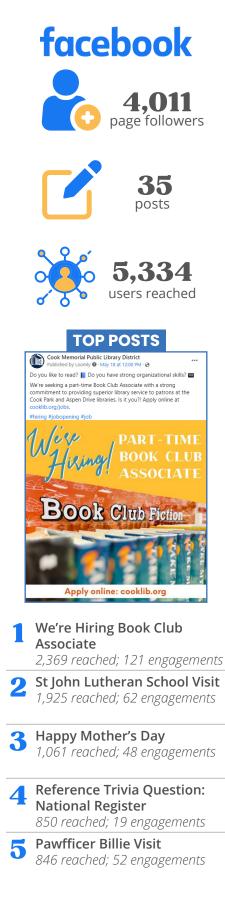

Local Partners and Taxing Bodies,

The Decennial Committees on Local Government Efficiency Act (PA 102-1088) requires certain local governments to establish special committees to study the responsibilities and areas for efficiency of the taxing authority and to submit their findings in a report to their county board.

What is PA 102-1088?

The Act states that local governments that may levy any tax (excluding municipalities and counties), must form a committee within one year of the effective date of the Act (June 10, 2022) and at least once every 10 years thereafter. Duties of the committee include the study of the local government's governing statutes, ordinances, rules, procedures, powers, jurisdiction, shared services, intergovernmental agreements, and interrelationships with other local governments and the State.

The Act also states that each committee shall summarize its work and findings within a written report, which shall include recommendations with respect to increased accountability and efficiency and provide the report to the county board in which the governmental unit is located no later than 18 months after the formation of the committee. <u>Read PA 102-1088</u>

Who is PA 1022-1088 applicable to?

The Act refers to local governments that may levy any tax (excluding municipalities and counties). Within Lake County, this includes but is not limited to:

- Community Colleges
- Drainage Districts
- Fire Protection Districts
- Forest Preserves
- Library Districts
- Mosquito Abatement Districts
- Park Districts
- Port Authorities
- Public Library Districts
- Sanitary Districts
- School Districts
- Townships
- Water Reclamation and Water Service Districts

If you are unsure if your organization falls under this Public Act, consult legal counsel.

The board of each public library is required by Illinois statute to decide annually whether the library will participate in the state's nonresident fee program. Nonresidents are defined as "a person who resides outside the taxing area of a public library" [75 ILCS 16/30-55.60]. Nonresidents have the option to annually purchase a library card at the closest participating library for a fee at least equal to the cost paid by residents.

The CMPLD board has traditionally supported the nonresident fee program even though there are no unserved areas adjacent to the Library's taxing area in which Cook Park or Aspen Drive is the closest library.

Approval of the attached resolution will to affirm the Library's continued participation in the nonresident card program, detailed under Public Act 92-1066, setting the annual fee for the card, using the State Library mathematical formula method, at \$417 per household effective July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING LIBRARY DIRECTOR AND FINANCE DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE REQUIRED PAPERWORK WITH ALL DESIGNATED, ELIGIBLE DEPOSITORY INSTITUTIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2023 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2024

WHEREAS, from time to time, the Library has excess funds from (a) property tax receipts and other revenue sources which can be invested and/or (b) the maturing of existing investments which can be re-invested; and

WHEREAS, good business sense would dictate investing these funds in interest-bearing accounts and/or certificates of deposit with different financial institutions to obtain the best return on any investment; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Director and Library Director, in conjunction with the Library's investment advisors, deposit library funds in interest-bearing accounts pursuant to the Library's investment policy; and

WHEREAS, whenever funds are moved to a different financial institution, the Library Board is required to authorize the deposit of funds with that institution; and

WHEREAS, in order to improve efficiency and eliminate delays in obtaining favorable interest rates for Library funds, the Finance Director and Library Director are authorized to execute such resolutions for all approved, eligible depository institutions for the fiscal year July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Director and Library Director shall notify the Board of all such deposits and changes at the Board's next regular monthly meeting.

Be It Resolved by the Board of Library Trustees of the Cook Memorial Public Library District, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: That all of the recitals contained above are hereby incorporated by reference.

<u>Section 2</u>: That the Library Director and Finance Director are authorized to execute all resolutions and documents required by all eligible depository institutions permitted by the Illinois Public Funds Investment Act and the Library's Investment Policy for the fiscal year July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024.

<u>Section 3</u>: That the officers listed in Section 2 are authorized and empowered to execute such other agreements, including but not limited to, special depository agreements and arrangements regarding the manner, conditions, or purposes for which funds, checks, or items of the Library District may be deposited, collected or withdrawn and to perform such other acts as they deem reasonably necessary to carry out the provisions of this Resolution.
